## Live Onsite Auction Guidelines

The following rules apply to all live onsite firearm auctions that occur onsite at the West Virginia State Treasurer's Office Records Warehouse.

- Firearm auction participation and sale is restricted to persons licensed as firearms collectors, dealers' importers, or manufacturers under the provisions of 18 U. S. C. §§921 et seq. and authorized to receive firearms under the terms of their license.
- All onsite live auctions conducted by the State Treasurer's Office will consist of up to 380 lots of multiple firearms. Onsite attendance required.
- All bids will be for individual lots.
- Live Auction dates and times will be posted on the Treasurer's web page, as well as email notifications sent out to pre-registered dealers.
- A lot-list containing a description of each firearm will be posted on the Treasurer's web site.
- Upon arrival, all pre-registered participants will have one hour to inspect firearms prior to the auction which commences at 9:00 AM on auction day.
- No early check-outs. Winning bidders must be present at the end of the auction to secure delivery and make payment.
- Firearms are sold AS IS. NO GUARANTEES WRITTEN OR IMPLIED.
- Accepted forms of payment are check or credit card.
- Firearms will not be shipped under any circumstance.
- Failure to comply with the rules set forth will result in the forfeiture of the firearms and they will be awarded to the next highest bidder.
- Upcoming auctions, both live and online will continue, and auctions details will continue to be updated on the Treasurer's website.
